- 5. I commit to work and pray for the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace with my fellow members at Grace Hill Church through humility, love, and forgiveness.
- 6. I commit to building up and strengthening the body of Christ at Grace Hill Church by using my spiritual gift(s) to the best of my ability.
- 7. I commit to a life of devotion by praying regularly for the leaders, members, and mission of the church.
- 8. I commit to contribute cheerfully and regularly to the church for the work of ministry, the relief of the poor and the spread of the gospel through all nations.
- 9. I desire to be kept accountable by the leaders and members at Grace Hill Church and to keep others accountable of the teachings of Scripture and of the members covenant.
- 10. I promise, if I move from this church, to leave with peace and to unite as soon as possible with another church body in order to carry out the principles of God's Word.
